Reuben (v6)	Survival, not extinction	Declines early; weak numbers; fades from history (1 Chr 5)	Grace preserves life despite loss of pre-eminence
Judah (v7)	Leadership, answered prayer, victory	Davidic kingship; military leadership	Christ the Lion of Judah; ultimate victory (Rev 5)
Levi (vv8–11)	Priesthood, Torah teaching, mediation	Temple service; teachers of the law	Christ the true High Priest; church as royal priesthood (Heb 7; 1 Pet 2)
Benjamin (v12)	Beloved, protected, dwelling place of God	Jerusalem/Temple region; Saul's rise and fall	Paul (Benjamite) → gospel to Gentiles (Rom 11:1)
Joseph (Ephraim & Manasseh) (vv13–17)	Fertility, strength, double portion	Dominant northern tribes; later apostasy & exile	Warning: blessing without faith fails; hope of restoration (Ezek 37)
Zebulun (v18)	Commerce, outward reach	Trade routes; coastal influence	Galilee receives Messiah first (Matt 4:13–16)
Issachar (v18)	Stability, learning	"Understanding the times" (1 Chr 12:32)	Wisdom to discern God's work in history
Gad (vv20–21)	Warrior courage, justice	Faithful fighters east of Jordan; early exile	Obedience even on the margins
Dan (v22)	Military strength	Early success → idolatry (Judg 18)	Omitted in Rev 7 — warning of apostasy
Naphtali (v23)	Favor, satisfaction, peace	Fertile land, quiet prosperity	Jesus' Galilean ministry overlaps territory
Asher (vv24–25)	Abundance, stability, endurance	Agricultural richness; longevity	Anna the prophetess awaits redemption (Luke 2)
